

Avenue Primary School - Litter Policy

This policy will be looked at every year and reviewed to make sure it is still useful.

The policy will be given to all classes and will be displayed on the Eco Schools notice board and in the reception area. It will also be given to the Premises Officer and be part of the Staff Handbook.

Why is it important to keep our school litter free?

We think that:

- Litter Looks bad and spoils our school environment.
- Litter can damage nature.
- Litter is dangerous.
- Litter can encourage pests and vermin.

What should be done with litter?

All litter should be put into bins.

If there is no bin nearby you should hold onto the litter until you are near a bin.

Litter monitors and a rota will be put in place for the Year 3/4 and Year 5/6 playgrounds. Year 1 and 2 children will help the Dinner Supervisors to pick up litter with the litter pickers when asked.

What should you do if you find a piece of litter?

If you find a piece of litter you can pick it up and put it in the bin or let a Litter Monitor know.

Use a litter picker to pick it up if it looks dirty.

Sharp litter should be picked up by an adult.
