They have a series of guides which are regularly updated on many different online topics.

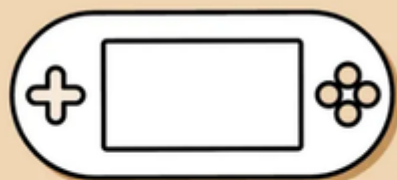
